#### What Must I do to be saved?

This simple, yet profound, question is the most important question that can be asked. "How can I be saved?" deals with where we will spend eternity after our lives in this world are over. Thankfully, the Bible is abundantly clear on how a person can be saved.

#### Why do I need to be saved?

We are all infected with sin (Romans 3:23). We are born with sin (Psalm 51:5), and we all personally choose to sin (Ecclesiastes 7:20: 1 John 1:8). Sin is what makes us unsaved. Sin is what separates us from God. Sin is what has us on the path to eternal destruction.

#### Saved from what?

Because of our sin, we all deserve death, "For the wages of sin is death," (Romans 6:23a). While the physical consequence of sin is physical death, that is not the only kind of death that results from sin. All sin is ultimately committed against an eternal and infinite God (Psalm 51:4). Because of that, the just penalty for our sin is also eternal and infinite. We need to be saved from eternal destruction (Matthew 25:46; Revelation 20:15).

#### How did God provide salvation?

Because the just penalty for sin is infinite and eternal, only God could pay the penalty, because only He is infinite and eternal. But God, in His divine nature, could not die. So God became a human being in the person of Jesus Christ. God took on human flesh, lived among us. When the people rejected Him and His message, and sought to kill Him, He willingly sacrificed Himself for us, allowing Himself to be crucified (John 10:15). Because Jesus Christ was human. He could die; and because Jesus Christ was God, His death had an eternal and infinite value. Jesus' death on the cross was the perfect and complete payment for our sin (1 John 2:2). He took the consequences we deserved. Jesus' resurrection from the dead demonstrated that His death was indeed the perfectly sufficient sacrifice for sin.

### What do I need to do?

"Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved" (Acts 16:31). God has already done all of the work. All you must do is agree with God that you have sinned and deserve eternal punishment, and receive, by faith, the salvation God offers (Ephesians 2:8-9). Fully trust in Jesus alone as the payment for your sins. God is offering you salvation as a gift. All you have to do is accept it. Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father but by me. (John 14:6).
